Certification...

The Georgia Certified Landscape Professional Exam consists of written exams and hands-on proficiency exams.

Written Exams (4 components)

General knowledge • Interpret a landscape plan • Pest identification • Plant identification

Hands-on Exams (8 components)

Landscape Plan Layout • Tree Planting & Staking • Grading & Drainage • Pruning • Sod Installation • Irrigation Operation & Maintenance • Pesticide Application • Equipment Operation

A passing grade of 70% on both the written and hands-on portions of the exam is required for the Georgia Certified Landscape Professional designation. A Georgia Certified Landscape Technician designation may be attained by passing the hands-on and plant identification portions.

Continuing Education

15 hours of CEUs are required every three years to remain certified.
